

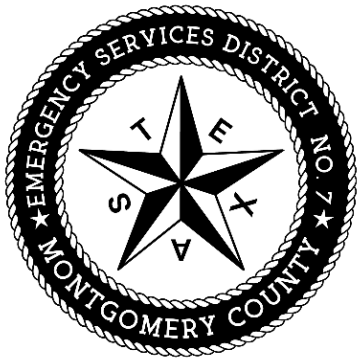
NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given that **MONTGOMERY COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 7** will hold a meeting on **May 28, 2026 at 1:00 PM** at the following location in the District: **13833 Highway 59 N. Splendora TX 77372**

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Call meeting to order, and establish a quorum.
2. To receive public comment (3 minutes per person).
3. To discuss and act on potential Board vacancy.
4. To approve the minutes of prior meeting(s).
5. To discuss and act to authorize Counsel to request an extension related to the District's 2025 audit.
6. To review and act on financial matters, including report from the District bookkeeper and Treasurer, to pay bills, determine investments, financial institutions/depositories, security agreements, and sales tax related items.
7. To designate the Montgomery County Tax Assessor-Collector's Office to prepare the District's No New Revenue Tax Rate and related tax rate calculations for 2026.
8. To review and take action on the ratification of a continuing Contract with a private law firm pursuant to §6.30 of the Tax Code for the collection of delinquent District ad valorem property taxes and providing for the payment of up to 20% of the delinquent taxes, penalties, and interest which are collected by the attorney under said Contract.
9. To discuss and take action on the imposition of additional penalty on delinquent taxes pursuant to §33.07 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same for taxes.
10. To discuss and take action on the imposition of additional penalty on delinquent taxes to defray costs of collection by the District's delinquent tax attorney, pursuant to §33.08 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same.
11. To discuss and take action on the imposition of early additional penalty for collection costs for taxes imposed on personal property on delinquent taxes pursuant to §33.11 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same
12. To review, discuss and act on communications regarding discontinuing service to areas outside of District.
13. To review and act on items related to construction, improvements, repairs, and renovations of District facilities.
14. To review and act on disposition of surplus and/or salvage property.
15. To review and act to acquire supplies, technology, equipment and vehicles, including financing and approval of any necessary resolutions related to same.

16. To review and act regarding real estate, including sale, purchase, financing, lease, platting, utilities, encumbrances and legal actions related to real estate.
17. To receive a report on Fire Department operations and activities, including action to approve expenses related to equipment and training, and proposed personnel policies and benefits.
18. To review, discuss and act regarding a policy related to legal fee reimbursements.
19. To review and act regarding an agreement with MCID.
20. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas and Tax Code §323.3022 to discuss sales tax matters.
21. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
22. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
23. To review and act on items discussed in Closed Session.
24. To review, discuss and act on personnel matters.
25. Review, discuss and take action to confirm the date for any future meetings.
26. Adjournment.
