Notice is hereby given that **MONTGOMERY COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 7** will hold a meeting on **September 24, 2026 at 1:00 PM** at the following location in the District: **13833 Highway 59 N. Splendora TX 77372**

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Call meeting to order, and establish a quorum.
2. To receive public comments (3 minutes per person).
3. To approve the minutes of prior meeting(s).
4. To review and act on financial matters, including report from the District bookkeeper and Treasurer, to pay bills, determine investments, financial institutions/depositories, security agreements, and sales tax related items.
5. To review, discuss and act regarding amendments to the 2025-2026 FY budget.
This is an item to address revisions to the Budget for the current Fiscal Year. Any revisions to the current Budget have no effect on the District's Tax Rate which was adopted on August 19, 2025 to fund the current Fiscal Year Budget. No action to revise or amend the current Budget can affect the Tax Rate which was previously adopted. Therefore, no Taxpayer Impact Statement is included.
6. To review, discuss and act on District personnel matters including but not limited to compensation, benefits, social security and retirement, scheduling, retention, hiring and/or termination of District employees.
7. To review, discuss and act on communications regarding discontinuing service to areas outside of District.
8. To review and act on items related to construction, improvements, repairs, and renovations of District facilities.
9. To review and act on disposition of surplus and/or salvage property.
10. To review and act to acquire supplies, technology, equipment and vehicles, including financing and approval of any necessary resolutions related to same.
11. To review and act regarding real estate, including sale, purchase, financing, lease, platting, utilities, encumbrances and legal actions related to real estate.
12. To receive a report on Fire Department operations and activities, including action to approve expenses related to equipment and training, and proposed personnel policies and benefits.
13. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas and Tax Code §323.3022 to discuss sales tax matters.
14. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.

15. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
16. To review and act on items discussed in Closed Session.
17. Review, discuss and take action to confirm the date for any future meetings.
18. Adjournment.
